First Reading

(Proverbs 8:17-21, 34-35) (Seated)

A reading from the Book of Proverbs

Wisdom says: "Those who love me, I also love, and those who seek me find me. With me are riches and honor, enduring wealth and prosperity. My fruit is better than gold, yes, than pure gold, and my revenue than choice silver. On the way of duty I walk, along the paths of justice, granting wealth to those who love me, and filling their treasuries. "Happy the person watching daily at my gates, waiting at my doorposts; for the one who finds me finds life, and wins favor from the LORD."

Responsorial Psalm

Offertory *(Seated)*

P — *(Stand)* Pray, brethren (brothers and sisters), that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

C — **May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.**

Prayer over the Offerings

P — Accept, O Lord, the offerings we bring you and grant that, enlightened by the Holy Spirit and encouraged by the example of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our hearts may always seek out and treasure the things that are yours. Through Christ our Lord.

P — The peace of the Lord be with you always.

Praise the Lord our God, for in Mary his handmaid he has fulfilled his promise of mercy to the house of Israel.

Prayer after Communion *(Stand)*

P — Let us pray. *(brief pause)*

Having received the Sacrament of salvation and of faith, we humbly beseech you, O Lord, that we, who devoutly honor the Blessed Virgin Mary, may be worthy to share with her in the charity of heaven.

Through Christ our Lord.

B — Amen.

Prayer to the Virgin of Peñafrancia

All — Turn to me thine eyes, Oh most loving Virgin of Peñafrancia and have mercy on my soul that come to thee, full of repentance.

Protect my family, relatives, friends and benefactors. Intercede for your devotees, both the living and the dead, especially for those whom I am most obliged to help.

Pray for me, console me, save me. In my hours of peril, adversity and afflictions, above all, in the hour of my death, appear before your Divine Son to help and defend me. Tell Him that I am your devotee, that having complete trust in your protection I kneel before your miraculous image to ask for your powerful intercession.

Virgin of Peñafrancia, Pray for me, help me, console me, and deliver me from all evil. Amen.
